

Garage Sales (See [Ordinance No. 76-96](#)) Rules & Regulations

- ⇒ "Garage Sale" means and includes all general sales, but not limited to all sales commonly referred to as garage, lawn, yard, attic, porch, room, backyard, patio, flea market, and/or rummage sale.
- ⇒ A garage sale is limited to personal property (i.e., property owned, utilized and maintained by an individual or member of his/her residence). It does not include merchandise purchased for resale or obtained on consignment.
- ⇒ Two or more neighbors may join together to conduct a garage sale at any one residence.
- ⇒ An applicant may not conduct a garage sale within six (6) months of a prior sale.

Garage Sale To-Dos:

- ✓ Visit City Hall to complete Garage Sale Application
- ✓ Pay \$5.00 Permit Fee
- ✓ Retain a copy of the Permit to be seen at the sale by the public, City Inspector or Police Department, if necessary.

Garage Sales (See [Ordinance No. 76-96](#)) Rules & Regulations

- ⇒ A resident shall file a permit application five (5) days in advance of the proposed sale.
- ⇒ **NO SIGNS** of any kind shall be permitted in relation to the garage sale or residential sale. (You may use balloons to identify your home.)
- ⇒ No sale items may be displayed in the front or side yard areas of the residence or in any public right of way.
- ⇒ All vehicle parking shall be conducted in compliance with all applicable laws and ordinances. The Police Department will alleviate any hazards created by the sale.
- ⇒ Any permit issued for a garage sale may be revoked if the application for the permit contains any false or misleading statements.

- ⇒ The garage sale permit in your possession should be posted on the premises in a conspicuous place to be seen by members of the public, or by any City Inspector, or police officer conducting an inspection of the regulations contained in [Ordinance No. 76-96](#).
