Dear Residents,

Summer is near and it's time to start thinking about spending some time at the pool and park. Whether you are a serious swimmer who wants to train for a triathlon during early morning lap swim or want your child to learn to play tennis, I hope you will spend a lot of time at Purvis Park this summer! Your property tax dollars are paying off the bonds that were sold in 1994 to build the pool and playground. By 2014 the bonds will be paid and we will own Purvis Park, debt-free.

The pool and playground at Purvis Park were built through the efforts of your fellow residents. In 1993, a group of 15 residents formed a committee, called the Citizens Committee for a New Purvis Park and Pool, that grew in size to more than 100 residents by 1994. They promoted the design of the new pool and park to other residents, convincing them to pay for the construction of what you see and enjoy today. At the time it was important to the community to have certain features and programs at Purvis Park. These included the pavilion, the 1-meter and 3-meter diving boards, a 30-foot high water slide, free arts & crafts for children two days a week, stories in the park, and separate swim nights for male and female swimmers.

The City has scrupulously maintained the pool and park so that it doesn't show its age. We want you to be proud of this lovely facility and have as much fun there today as you had if you were there the day it opened in 1995. Enjoy Purvis Park and all that it has to offer you this summer. Please be safe, careful and respectful of others while you are using the park and pool. Thank you for your use of this facility and for your support of its programs. Have a wonderful summer!
