

PUBLIC NOTICE OF CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION
FIREFIGHTER 3rd GRADE
CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, OHIO

The City of University Heights Civil Service Commission announces an open competitive Entrance Examination for the position of **FIREFIGHTER 3rd GRADE**. The written examination will be administered on **Saturday, March 24, 2012**, at 9:00 a.m. at Wiley Middle School Cafeteria, 2181 Miramar Boulevard, University Heights, Ohio.

The City of University Heights requires each applicant to submit a current certificate of completion for the firefighter agility test administered by Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C) with a passing time of 4 minutes and 30 seconds or less. The next physical agility test offered by Tri-C will be held on February 19, 2012. No applicant will be permitted to take the written examination unless the firefighter agility test certificate of completion is submitted with the application.

Applications will be available at University Heights City Hall, 2300 Warrensville Center Road beginning Monday, February 27, 2012 at 8:30 a.m. Applications will be accepted from the first 100 applicants upon payment of \$20.00 fee and must be returned by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, March 9, 2012.

Applicants must be U.S. citizen, shall be 21 years of age, but not over 35, as of the date on which he/she may be appointed, high school graduate (or GED) and have a valid driver's license. Each applicant for the position of Firefighter 3rd Grade shall submit prior to examination a current National Registered or Ohio EMT-P paramedic certificate. Extra credit is given for the following categories: one year or more of military service credit (10%) and at least 240 hours or more Ohio Fire School (1%). Such proof must be provided at the time of filing application.

The City of University Heights is an equal opportunity employer, and all persons otherwise qualified who have not attained the age of thirty-six shall be eligible for original appointment for City employment without regard to race, creed, color, religion, national origin, sex, or age.
