PUBLIC HEARING: The City of University Heights is eligible to apply for funding available from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. The CDBG program provides up to \$150,000 reimbursement to municipalities to help strengthen cities and to improve quality of life through projects like infrastructure and accessibility improvements. The project under consideration for funding is streetscape improvements and intersection modifications at Cedar and South Taylor Roads. A public hearing will be held on Wednesday, December 7 at 6:30 PM in the Council Chambers at University Heights City Hall, 2300 Warrensville Center Road, University Heights, Ohio 44118. The hearing will give citizens an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed CDBG program application before submission on December 23, 2016. Funding eligibility and proposed project details will be discussed at the public hearing. Citizens are encouraged to attend this meeting in order to express their views and comments on the City's proposed project or to submit opinions in writing to the address above.
