A recent financial audit of the City of University Heights by the Auditor of State's office has returned a clean audit report. University Height's excellent record keeping has earning it the *Auditor of State Award*.

In response to the *Auditor of State Award*, Mayor Susan Infeld said, "We are honored to receive this award acknowledging the responsible management practices of our resident's tax dollars."

The *Auditor of State Award* is presented to local governments and school districts upon the completion of a financial audit. Entities that receive the award meet the following criteria of a "clean" audit report:

- The entity must file timely financial reports with the Auditor of State's office in accordance with GAAP (Generally Accepted Accounting Principles);
- The audit report does not contain any findings for recovery, material citations, material weaknesses, significant deficiencies, Single Audit findings or questioned costs;
- The entity's management letter contains no comments related to:
 - Ethics referrals:
 - Questioned costs less than \$10,000;
 - o Lack of timely report submission;
 - Reconciliation:
 - o Failure to obtain a timely Single Audit;
 - Findings for recovery less than \$100;
 - Public meetings or public records.
