Dear Residents:

Over the past year, the city staff and I have been working with NOACA transportation planners on a pedestrian and bicycle improvement project for Warrensville and Cedar Roads. The final report, which will identify suggested improvements for these streets, will be released soon and posted to the city website. Throughout the past year the city administration has also been involved with the Eastside Greenway, a countywide project connecting existing bicycle paths and identifying new paths. The project is nearing completion and will serve as a map for bicyclists that will connect them to points of interest around the county. Our next project is a new master plan for the city. The County Planning Commission will develop the master plan with input from residents, community stakeholders, city staff and your elected representatives. Once complete, it will be a guideline for development in University Heights for the next ten years. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions about any of these projects.
