Message from the Mayor

Dear Residents,

I would like to invite you to a Community Safety Meeting on Wednesday, August 16th at 7 p.m. in the Donahue Auditorium of the Dolan Science Center at John Carroll University. Entrance to the building is on the east and west sides and there is plentiful parking. A panel including Police Chief Steven Hammett, Law Director Luke McConville, and Prosecutor William (Bud) Doyle will present safety statistics for our city and share information about the criminal investigation process. We would like to hear your concerns and answer your questions about crime and safety in University Heights. We will also provide information about recent legislative initiatives. I hope to see you there!

Cuyahoga County will fund competitive grants for city improvement projects and we are busily researching ideas. We would also like to hear your project ideas and welcome your suggestions! Please come to a meeting at City Hall on Monday, August 14th at 6:30 p.m. for refreshments and idea-sharing. The County grants will fund commercial storefront improvements, and programs or capital improvements for two city neighborhoods. The two eligible neighborhoods are: 1) the Cedar-Green area, including streets between Cedar and Groveland, and between Fenway (east of Green) and Belvoir; and 2) the Cedar-Taylor area, including streets between Silsby and Washington, and between Barrington and Taylor. For those who buy and sell through internet sales sites, please know that the University Heights Police Department parking lot is a designated *safe site* for completing internet sales arrangements. The lot is located in front of the Police Department building at 2304 Warrensville Center Road, closest to the City Hall building, and south of Silsby. The parking lot is monitored around the clock with video cameras.

Good news! Cuyahoga County has reported that the median home sale price in University Heights has increased to \$147,750, a 15% increase over the last year. This ranks the City of University Heights at the exact middle of median home sale prices county-wide. Thank you for your outstanding home maintenance efforts that attract buyers to our city!

The students from Monticello and Roxboro Middle Schools will relocate to the Wiley campus later this month while their schools are being renovated over the next two years. The traffic pattern established two years ago for the temporary high school will remain the same for the middle school drop-off and pick-up. We welcome the middle school students to University Heights and wish the high school students a good school year in their brand new building on Cedar Road! Go Tigers!
