Residential Lock-Box Program

Recommended for senior citizens & disabled residents, but available to all residents.

An incident may occur when a resident may be unable to open the door for Firefighters/Paramedics in the event of an emergency. Our only way of getting into the resident's home may be to break a window or the door. This may cause damage and additional costs to the resident.

The University Heights Fire Department now offers the Residential Lock-Box Program. This is a great resource for a resident who is living alone, with no one close by to help them in an emergency. Installation of the Lock-Box is free of charge for all residents.

Please contact the University Heights Fire Department with any questions. A Lock-Box Application can be found on the City website as well as picked up at the Fire Department. Residents can choose between the two boxes below:

- Mail or drop off check and application to the Fire Department, Attn. Fire Prevention Bureau
- Lock-Box Keys are securely locked on University Heights Fire Apparatus
- The University Heights Fire Department will keep a data base along with the Heights Hillcrest Communications Center to track where each lock box is located
