A RESOLUTION LEVYING TAX YEAR 2020 SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,000,000.00 FOR THE CORE RETAIL PARCEL IN THE UNIVERSITY SQUARE DEVELOPMENT, PERMANENT PARCEL NO. 721-01-001, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of University Heights is a party to a certain Cooperative Agreement together with the Cleveland-Cuyahoga County Port Authority and the property owner (the “Cooperative Agreement”) in connection with the \$40,500,000.00 Cleveland-Cuyahoga County Port Authority Senior Special Assessment/Tax Increment Revenue Bonds, Series 2001A (University Heights, Ohio – Public Parking Garage Project), dated December 1, 2001 and Cleveland-Cuyahoga County Port Authority Subordinate Tax Increment Revenue Bonds, Series 2001B (the “Bonds”);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3.2(b) of the Cooperative Agreement, the City is obligated to annually “levy and collect special assessments from the property benefited by the Project in amounts sufficient to pay Debt Service Charges and Administrative Expenses” on the Bonds;

WHEREAS, the debt service to pay the Bonds was to be generated from payments made by the owners of certain parcels in lieu of real estate taxes generated by those parcels comprising the University Square development, and if the payment proved to be insufficient to repay the debt service on the Bonds, the debt service would be secured by special assessments on said parcels;

WHEREAS, the special assessments are certified for the sole purpose of protecting and benefiting the bondholders and currently serve only to secure the defaulted Bond payments owed to such bondholders;

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2001, the City adopted the resolution of necessity pursuant to the requirements of Section 727.12 of the Ohio Revised Code and passed the ordinance to proceed for the acquisition, construction, installation, equipment and improvement of the University Square Project;

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2001, the City passed the assessing ordinance pursuant to the requirements of Section 727.25 of the Ohio Revised Code for the levying of the special assessments;

WHEREAS, UMB Bank, as Trustee for the bondholders, has demanded that the special assessment in the agreed-upon amount of \$4,000,000.00 be levied for tax year 2020 on the Core Retail Parcel (PPN 722-01-001); and

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga County has extended the City’s deadline for certification of the tax year 2020 special assessment to November 6, 2020;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. The Council hereby levies a special assessment in the amount of Four Million and 00/100 Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) on the Core Retail Parcel (PPN 721-01-001) of the University Square Project, such amount being agreed upon by the parties to the Cooperative Agreement and the City to be equal in amount to the debt service charges and administrative expenses payable on the Bonds during the annual period.

Section 2. The Finance Director shall prepare an assessment for tax year 2020 in accordance with the Cooperative Agreement and Section 1 hereof above. The Finance Director

shall file a copy of said assessment with the Clerk of Council and deliver the same to the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Office for filing on the tax duplicate for tax year 2020.

Section 3. The Council determines the method of collection of said special assessment shall be via certification by the Finance Director of said special assessments to the County Fiscal Officer of Cuyahoga County, Ohio, for collection in the same manner as City property taxes upon the property tax duplicates for collection in the subsequent year. The Finance Director shall perform the certification of said special assessment for tax year 2020 for collection in 2021 in the manner prescribed by the County Fiscal Officer of Cuyahoga County, Ohio and Council hereby direct the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Office to take any steps necessary to certify this special assessment to the tax duplicate for tax year 2020.

Section 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety, health and welfare of the citizens of the City of University Heights, the emergency being the need to certify special assessments to the County Fiscal Office by the applicable deadline. It shall therefore become effective upon its passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members of Council and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall become effective at the earliest time allowed by law.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, OHIO THAT:**

Section 1. To provide for the current expenses and other expenditures for the City of University Heights, Ohio for the period commencing January 1, 2020 and ending December 31, 2020, City Council authorizes the Amended Permanent Appropriations as herein set forth.

Section 2. We have received two (2) distributions from the Cuyahoga County Budget Commission for CARES Act funding approved for University Heights. The first disbursement was made in July in the amount of \$465,644.62. Subsequently, in September we received another disbursement of \$232,822.31. We are also scheduled, on October 15, to receive the last distribution of \$461,149.42.

The total CARES Act monies we will have on hand after the October 15th disbursement will be \$1,159,616.35. That funding will be used to support salary and benefit expenses for the Police and Fire Departments and for various COVID related materials and supplies the City purchased over the course of the last seven (7) months.

Last month, via Ordinance 2020-40, we appropriated a total of \$350,000 (\$75k Salary and \$275k Other) to departmental codes within Fund 297 – Local Coronavirus Relief Fund. At that time, we were uncertain of both: the final determinations as to what the CARES Act could be used for and what additional (if any) distributions were planned for the remainder of 2020.

We now are aware that we may use CARES Act funding for safety forces salary and benefit expenses incurred after the pandemic declaration in March 2020. Further, our Law Director has issued an opinion in support of the various advisories we have received from the Federal and State governments. We also now know the amount of the final CARES disbursement to be deposited in our bank by the County on October 15.

Given the above, I would request Council approve appropriating the remainder of the CARES Act monies available to make use of the entire available balance (after October 15) of \$1,159,616.35. Those funds will require appropriations in the following amounts for 2020 in order to deplete the available balance and make use of the complete CARES Act distributions:

FUND 297	Salary	\$1,082,616.35
FUND 297	Other	\$77,000.00

Once these appropriations have been approved by Council and filed with the County, we will begin the process of transferring previously incurred safety forces expenses from the General Fund to Fund 297 (Local Coronavirus Relief Fund). These appropriation levels replace and expand the original amounts approved in Ordinance No. 2020-40.

The total salary expense (not including pension or medical insurance) for the safety forces' union staff for the period April 2020 through September 2020 is as follows:

POLICE	\$1,300,690.65
FIRE	\$1,152,346.63

We will proportionately distribute the salary expense of these departments to Fund 297 prior to the end of October. We have allotted \$77,000 in Fund 297 to absorb the costs of various COVID-related materials and supplies. I believe that there have been sufficient expenses incurred to date in the General Fund that will satisfy the requirements of the CARES Act funds usage as determined by the various advisories disseminated by the Federal and State governments. Such usage is also consistent with the opinion rendered by our Law Director.

The expenses charged through journal entry to Fund 297 will be supported by fund balance generated from the three (3) CARES Act disbursements executed by the County. When those expenses post to Fund 297, it is important to recognize that both the original appropriations supporting the expenses *and* the fund balance of the General Fund will be restored. We should discuss what adjustments, if any, that may be made prior to year end to reduce the appropriation level of the General Fund.

From a fund balance perspective, the General Fund balance will increase by any amount ultimately transferred as expense to the Local Coronavirus Relief Fund. For all intents and purposes, that figure will be the \$1,159,616.35 disbursed to us as of October 15. Using the entire allocation will prevent us from having to return any of the funding to the County.

ORDINANCE 2020-51

INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR MICHAEL DYLAN BRENNAN

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING PAID ADMINISTRATIVE LEAVE FOR FURLOUGHED ADMINISTRATIVE EMPLOYEES COMMENSURATE WITH THE LENGTH OF THE FURLOUGH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of University Heights is the recipient of CARES Act funding issued pursuant to section 601(d) of the Social Security Act and as supplemented by section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (“CARES Act”);

WHEREAS, certain CARES Act funds may be used to cover payroll expenses for eligible health and safety workers whose services are substantially dedicated to mitigating or responding to the COVID-19 public health emergency;

WHEREAS, use of CARES Act funds to cover payroll expenses for health and safety workers whose services are substantially dedicated to mitigating or responding to the COVID-19 public health emergency will improve the fund balance in the City’s general fund;

WHEREAS, various City employees in administrative capacities were placed on furlough or received reductions in salary during 2020 to help mitigate projected budget shortfalls due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, since the City has received substantial CARES Act funding, the City wishes to relieve its administrative employees of the burden of taking pay reductions by granting paid administrative leave to cover the periods of furlough coinciding with the closure of City buildings pursuant to issuance of an Executive Order of the Mayor;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1: Except as otherwise set forth herein, each administrative City employee placed on furlough or incurring a reduction in salary during 2020 shall receive, retroactively, paid administrative leave in an amount commensurate with the length of the employee’s furlough. The paid administrative leave benefit hereunder shall be paid to each employee in a lump sum in accordance with the City’s customary payroll practices, provided, however, that employees shall not receive credit for any additional Ohio Public Employee Retirement System service time or Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund service time in connection with such paid administrative leave.

Section 2: Elected officials are not eligible to receive the paid administrative leave benefit approved herein.

Section 3: Paid administrative leave benefits approved herein shall be paid out of the City’s General Fund. The City Finance Director is hereby authorized to execute any applicable payments necessary to comply with the terms of this ordinance.

Section 4: This Ordinance and the benefits conferred hereunder apply only to affected administrative employees who are in active pay status as of the date of the ordinance taking effect.

Section 5: The Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which results in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the ORC.

Section 6: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, so that the City can expeditiously pay administrative leave benefits to employees to restore their lost income and mitigate any hardship caused thereby; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 2020-31

INTRODUCED BY: COUNCILMAN GOULD

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 280.04 ENTITLED “PUBLIC HEARINGS; NOTICE OF PROPERTY TRANSFERS TO THE CITY BEAUTIFUL CORPORATION.”

WHEREAS, the University Heights City Beautiful Corporation is a community improvement corporation created to promote the health, safety, and general welfare of its residents, and growth and development of business and industry within the City through engagement in community development activities;

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the City’s community improvement corporation will participate in the development of real property and improvements thereon located throughout the City;

WHEREAS, in order to promote transparency and highlight the role of the University Heights City Beautiful Corporation in promoting development throughout the City, Council wishes to ~~conduct public hearings and~~ create notice requirements in connection with the transfer of any City-owned real property to the University Heights City Beautiful Corporation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, that:

Section 1. Codified Ordinance Chapter 280.04 entitled “Public Hearings; Notice of Property Transfers to the City Beautiful Corporation” is hereby enacted and shall read in its entirety as follows:

SECTION 280.04 PUBLIC HEARINGS; NOTICE OF PROPERTY TRANSFERS TO THE CITY BEAUTIFUL CORPORATION.

Prior to any transfer, conveyance, sale or disposition of any City-owned real property and/or improvements to the University Heights City Beautiful Corporation, City Council must approve such transfer by ordinance, resolution or motion. the City shall conduct a public hearing to solicit public comment. Notice of the Council meeting at which such transfer will be considered shall be given by such public hearing shall be given as follows: (i) mailed notices shall be given to the record owners of any real property located within 200 feet from the exterior boundaries of the subject City-owned property, not less than seven (7) days prior to the date of the Council Meeting public hearing, (ii) mailed notices shall be given to members of City Council not less than seven (7) days prior to the date of the public hearing, and (iii) posted notice to the general public in the manner set forth in City of University Heights Codified Ordinance Section 206.02. The failure to deliver notice as provided in this section shall not invalidate the public hearing or any transfer, conveyance, sale or disposition of property to the University Heights City Beautiful Corporation.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action occurred in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) offers an Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) program. Through this program they support the needs of public safety in local communities.

The primary goal of the AFG is to enhance the safety of the public and firefighters with respect to fire-related hazards by providing direct financial assistance to eligible fire departments, nonaffiliated EMS organizations, and State Fire Training Academies. This funding is for critically needed resources to equip and training emergency personnel to recognized standards, enhance operations efficiencies, foster interoperability, and support community resilience. This grant opportunity does not have a maximum award. The matching funds are 5% of the total request.

This year the Fire Department focused the grant on safety equipment and training related to technical rescue. All UHFD technical rescue equipment was previously retired due to a lack of maintenance, expired service dates, and improper storage. The new UHFD tower ladder provides additional technical rescue advantages that we were not equipped or trained for. Although UHFD is part of a regional technical rescue team, our members first responding into a technical rescue incident need to have basic training and awareness.

After careful consideration, FEMA has determined that our project submitted including the application, project narrative, request details, and budget information was consistent for an award.

The Fire Department obtained your approval to apply for grants on April 20, 2020. I am happy to announce that on September 2, 2020 the Fire Department received official notification that the \$127,140 grant project was approved. FEMA is contributing \$121,085.71 to the award and the city must provide matching funds of \$6,054.29.

Therefore, I am respectfully requesting the approval to accept the FY2019 FEMA AFG Grant for the purchase of technical rescue equipment and training.

As part of the Ohio Department of Public Safety, the Ohio Emergency Medical Services (EMS) offers an EMS equipment Grant Program. Through this program they support the needs of public safety in local communities.

The purpose of the Ohio EMS Grant Program is to provide funding for equipment purchases and to improve quality and accessibility to emergency medical services in Ohio. This grant opportunity has no maximum but typically awards our Fire Department approximately \$3,000. There are no matching costs associated with this grant.

This year the Fire Department would like the grant to focus on EMS equipment for active shooter incidents, known as Rescue Task Force (RTF). This equipment is used for Firefighter/Paramedics entering the warm zone of an active shooter incident. The equipment is comprised of a ballistic vest and helmet, and medical supplies for traumatic injuries associated with high-powered ammunition. The Fire Department is actively engaging in active shooter training this year and plans on participating in more larger scale drills with our Police Department and other neighboring communities.

After careful consideration, the Ohio Department of EMS has determined that our grant submitted was consistent for an award.

The Fire Department obtained your approval to apply for grants on April 20, 2020. I am happy to announce that the Fire Department received official notification that the grant project was approved. Ohio EMS is contributing \$2,846.43 to the award. There are no matching costs associated with this grant.

Therefore, I am respectfully requesting the approval to accept the 2020-2021 Ohio EMS Grant for the purchase of RTF gear for the Fire Department.
