Bids for the purchase of two Kubota refuse collection vehicles were opened Friday April 30, 2021.

Following are the results:

ABC Equipment Rental & Sales of Brunswick Hills, Ohio bid \$16,987 each, total \$32,974.00 for two.

Mentor MFG of Mentor, Ohio bid \$18,960.61 each, total \$37,921.22 for two.

The City operates a total of six refuse collection scooters; four for daily collection on the routes and two spares utilized for back up & special pickups. At this time the City Service Department would like to replace two units, Unit 206 a 2013 & Unit 202 a 2016 Kubota which recently went out of service due to a broken transmission.

I respectfully request City Councils award of this bid to ABC Equipment Rental & Sales of Brunswick Hills, Ohio for \$32,974.00 as the lowest and best bid. Funds for this purchase were budgeted in account 400-1420-56010.

On 10-19-20 the University Heights Police Department was awarded \$4,536.00 from the Bureau of Justice Assistance as a result of the department’s recurring grant application through the Patrick Leahy Bulletproof Vest Partnership program.

This award under Fiscal Year 2020 would be utilized to reimburse 50% of all National Institute of Justice compliant bulletproof vest purchases by the department through 08-31-22.

The agency currently has 9 officers due for a replacement vest in 2021, and this grant award would be utilized to offset the total replacement cost of \$5,156 for these 9 vests.

At this time, I respectfully request administrative/legislative approval and authorization to accept the aforementioned award to be utilized in the said manner.

Awards will not be extended past that date, and any unused funds will be forfeited.

Re: Authorization to bid Temporary Labor Staffing for 2021-2023

The use of temporary staffing by the Service Department provides an ability collect leaves & brush, and other solid waste during the fall season and also provides additional labor following storms, or on an as needed basis.

I respectfully request City Council authorize bidding for this service to be used during the next three years (2021-2023).

The estimated cost of these services is approximately \$15,000 per year and in the past has been funded by the Tree Improvement Fund 205-4407-54250.
