HOME SECURITY CHECKLIST

This checklist is only a guide to assist with making your home safer. If you mark NO to anything on the list are areas where you may want to take action to improve your home's security. There is no guarantee that this checklist will prevent crime, but may deter crime.

EXTERIOR DOORS		
All doors are locked at night and when away from the home	1. YES	_ NO
2. Doors are solid hardwood or metal-clad	2. YES	_ NO
