A meeting was held at the Beachwood fire station on September 1, 2022.

Captain Coppora gave a tour of the Beachwood fire station facility. The following points were noted:

- Beachwood has their own dispatch center which should not be a part of the square footage
- There are expensive add-ons which they know are not standard
- There is at the reception area a large work space that is never used with computers, desks, and a tv screen
- There are 15 per shift and 11 minimum per shift with two fire stations
- The living space is on the first floor which is excellent for getting to the bays, but not practical, if someone is being constrained
- There are 10 bunks and 5 bathrooms with doors on each bunk. Each room has lockers because shifts share the same room at different times
- There is a laundry room and a janitor room by the bunks
- There is a weight room on two floors
- A separate movie room exists
- The kitchen is spacious with upgrades on the tile, etc.
- There is an electric room
- There are 3 captain's offices – extra
- There is an oversized lieutenant office
- There is an oversized training room

BAY AREA

The bay area is 4,700 sq. ft.

- There are two decontamination rooms; one for gear and one for people
- There is a clothing gear room
- There is a special room with a dryer for gear
- There is a maintenance area
- The ceiling is acoustical
- There are 14 X 14 bay doors that are top-of-the line and open side to side
- They have both sides open but prefer to back in
- There is unfinished space for growth

LIKES

The weight room is separated on two floors

The lockers are on the bay floor
