

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-10

INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR SUSAN K. INFELD

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A GRANT APPLICATION FROM THE OHIO ARTS COUNCIL ARTSTART PROGRAM IN SUPPORT OF PUBLIC ART AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF CEDAR AND SOUTH TAYLOR ROADS.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Arts Council has funding to award grants for eligible projects located in the City of University Heights that promote the arts through community engagement and the goals and objectives of the Ohio Arts Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of University Heights is eligible to apply for ArtSTART funding based on being a qualified applicant within the Ohio Arts Council's service area; and

WHEREAS, the City of University Heights intends to submit a project proposal funding request that will engage the community to create public art for a new public square located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Cedar and South Taylor Roads; and

WHEREAS, the ArtSTART program requires a one-to-one matching cash funds from the City of University Heights.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Authorization is given to Mayor Susan K. Infeld to submit this grant application to the Ohio Arts Council for the ArtSTART program and to execute a contract with the Ohio Arts Council and expend funds necessary to complete the project requirements if selected for funding.

Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety, health and welfare of the citizens of the City of University Heights; such reason being that this resolution must be enacted in order to present the proposed project at a public meeting prior to submission of the required application documents. It shall therefore become effective upon its passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members of Council and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall become effective at the earliest time allowed by law.


