A RESOLUTION FOR COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS AND CLEVELAND HEIGHTS TO SUBMIT APPLICATION TO THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION (OPWC) FOR THE WASHINGTON BLVD. REHABILITATION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of University Heights and The City of Cleveland Heights enter into a cooperation agreement to submit an application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for the Washington Boulevard Rehabilitation Project.

WHEREAS, the City of University Heights will provide funds equal to 17% percent of the total project cost. Such funds will come from the Street Maintenance Fund (201).

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland Heights will provide funds equal to 4% percent of the total project cost.

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland Heights authorizes The City of University Heights to serve as lead applicant and to sign all necessary documents.

WHEREAS, the City of University Heights agrees to pay its 17% of the cost as invoices are due / at the end of the project / as otherwise agreed upon.

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland Heights agrees to pay its 4% of the cost as invoices are due / at the end of the project / as otherwise agreed upon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, OHIO AND COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a cooperation agreement with Cleveland Heights to submit an application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for the Washington Boulevard Rehabilitation Project.

Section 2. The Mayor is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance in conjunction with the recommendations of the City Engineer, and approved as to form by the City Law Director, in accordance with all authority granted to and limitations upon by the City Director of Finance.

<u>Section 3.</u> It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance of all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare and shall therefore be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
