AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT), OFFICE OF CONTRACTS, TO PURCHASE SODIUM CHLORIDE (ROCK SALT) FOR THE 2018-2019 WINTER SEASON.

WHEREAS, the City of University Heights has need to purchase road salt for the 2018-2019 winter season to maintain safe streets;

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation, Office of Contracts, Purchasing Services provides the opportunity to participate in the State purchasing program; and

WHEREAS, Service Director Jeffrey Pokorny has determined purchasing road salt for the 2018-2019 winter season from the Ohio Department of Transportation is the most dependable way to secure a road salt contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, OHIO, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Mayor, with the approval of the Director of Law, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation, Office of Contracts, Purchasing Services, as attached hereto as Exhibit "A", for the purchase of sodium chloride (rock salt) for the 2018-2019 winter season.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Director of Finance is authorized to issue warrants for the payment upon receipt of the proper invoices.

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Resolution constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of University Heights, Ohio, and for the additional reason that the agreement must be received by ODOT prior to May 18, 2018 to have road salt available for delivery for the 2018-2019 winter season, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members of Council, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall become effective at the earliest time allowed by law.
