A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT OF \$142,965 FROM CUYAHOGA COUNTY FOR THE 2018 CEDAR/SOUTH GREEN TRAFFIC CALMING PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga County offers pass-through federal grant funding in the form of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) awards; and

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga County has awarded a Community Development Block Grant award to the City of University Heights in the amount of \$142,965.00 for a traffic calming project; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant award requires no matching fund from the City of University Heights.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, OHIO THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> Mayor Michael Dylan Brennan is hereby authorized to accept the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) award in the amount of \$142,965.00 from Cuyahoga County for the traffic calming project.

Section 2. The Council finds and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety, health and welfare of the citizens of the City of University Heights. It shall therefore become effective upon its passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members of Council and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall become effective at the earliest time allowed by law.
