## A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR A GRANT FROM THE 2019 CUYAHOGA COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Council has allocated Community Development Supplemental Grant funding to award annual grants through a competitive process for eligible projects within the fifty-nine communities and 501(c)(3) community development corporations; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Supplemental Grant funding can be used for projects that help strengthen cities, encourage regional collaboration, and improve quality of life for our residents; and

WHEREAS, the City of University Heights is eligible to apply for Community Development Supplemental Grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of University Heights intends to submit a Community Development Supplemental Grant project proposal funding request that will benefit the health and welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS, funding requests for a maximum of \$50,000 must be submitted by November 30, 2018 for the project period January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the 2019 Community Development Supplemental Grant requires no matching cash funds from the City of University Heights.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, OHIO, THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> Authorization is given to Mayor Michael Dylan Brennan to submit this grant application to the Cuyahoga County Department of Development for the Community Development Supplemental Grant Program and to execute a contract with Cuyahoga County if selected for funding.

<u>Section 2.</u> It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety, health and welfare of the citizens of the City of University Heights; such reason being that this resolution must be enacted in order to present the proposed project at a public meeting prior to submission of the required application documents by November 30, 2018. It shall therefore become effective upon its passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members of Council and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall become effective at the earliest time allowed by law.
