A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A \$2,500.00 GRANT AWARD FROM THE FIRST SUBURBS DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (FSDC) TO PURCHASE FIELD TECHNOLOGY AS PART OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW CODE ENFORCEMENT SOFTWARE.

WHEREAS, FSDC sought grant funding through the Cleveland Foundation to assist the 6 communities implementing new code enforcement software purchase field technology; and

WHEREAS, University Heights, along with Cleveland Heights, Shaker Heights, South Euclid, and Parma, is implementing the new code enforcement software program; and

WHEREAS, the City of University Heights was awarded \$2,500 through FSDC's award from the Cleveland Foundation and has purchased field technology to implement the new code enforcement software program; and

WHEREAS, with the field technology, the City of University Heights and its Housing and Building Departments will maintain the high level of service its residents expect and modernize service delivery.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Authorization is given to Mayor Michael Dylan Brennan to accept this grant award from FSDC in the amount of \$2,500.00.

Section 2. The Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which results in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the ORC.
